NY, Will dated 2 Jun 1827, probated July 3 1832; includes wife Anna; sons Dan, Benjamin, George, Cornelius; daughters Sally Ann, Jane, Katherine and Rachel Crispel; executors is the wife and sons Dan and Benjamin.

Will of William Lane, June 2, 1827 Olive, Ulster County New York, Cayuga County File Box #10: The last Will and Testament of William Lane of the town of Olive in the county of Ulster and state of New York. William Lane considering the uncertainty of his mortal life and being of sound mind and memory, blessed be Almighty God for the same, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and from following, viz., After my just debts and funeral expenses are discharged, which said debts and expenses I order and will shall be paid by my sons, Dan Lane, Benjamin Lane and George Lane --I do give and bequeath unto my said sons Dan and George the farm where I now reside to be divided equally between them, share and share alike and to their heirs and assigns forever --I do give and devise unto my son Benjamin all the land that I purchased, of Jacob Lounsbery, lying in the town of Olive aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever; for a description of said land reference may be had to the deeds given me by the said Lounsbery --I do give and divide unto my son Cornelius Lane all the remainder of the lot out of which I have given my said son Cornelius a deed for of fifty acres lying in the town of Olive formerly in the town of Hurley, reserving out of this same unto my sons, Dan, Benjamin and George the right of cutting and carrying away from the same all such timber as much as they shall want for the space of fourteen years after my decease --I do give unto my said sons Dan, Benjamin and George each an equal right and privilege in my gristmill and sawmill and to their heirs and assigns forever I do give unto my sons Dan and Benjamin each the colt which they now call their own --I do give unto my daughters Sally Ann Lane, Jane Lane and Katherine Lane each two good cows, six sheep, one good bed and bedding, with curtains and the sum of fifty dollars to be paid to my said daughters when they shall respectively arrive to the age of twenty one years unless they shall get married before they arrive at that age, and in that case I will that their several legacies to be paid to my said daughters at the time of their marriage by my said sons Dan, Benjamin and George --I do further will and order that my wife Anne shall be provided with a good and suitable maintenance during her natural life, or as long as she shall remain my widow, and that she together with my said sons Dan, Benjamin and George and my said daughters shall continue to reside together and that my said daughters shall be brought up and provided for by my said last mentioned sons, and if my said sons shall neglect or refuse to provide for their mother in a suitable and decent manner --I do then will that she shall claim her right of dower; --I do further give unto my sons John Lane, Joseph C Lane and my daughter Rachel Crispel each the sum of ten shillings to be paid by my said sons Dan, Benjamin and George and all the remainder of my personal property of whatever kind or nature --I do give unto my sons Dan, Benjamin and George to be divided between them, share and share alike. And it is my further will that my said son George shall not be put in possession of any part of his legacy until he shall become twenty one years of age and unless he shall perform his equal part of what is required of him in this my will. And lastly I do

here by constitute and appoint my said wife Anne and my sons Dan and Benjamin, executress and executors of this my last Will and Testament --In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the second day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven. Signed // William Lane

Signed, sealed, published and declared by the above named William Lane to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses in the presence of the testator. Signed//Stephen Matthews, Reuben Krom Jr, I.D.L. Montanye.

Petition to Will, Surrogate Court of Cayuga County, New York, February 14, 1832: mentions William Lane, late of the town of Brutus, now deceased, died in the said town of Brutus on or about the 10th day of October last . He left at the time of his death a widow, Anna Lane; Rachael wife of John Crispell of Woodstock; John Lane of Olive; Joseph C Lane of Green County; Cornelius Lane of Olive; Benjamin Lane of Brutus; George Lane of Brutus; Sally Ann lane of Brutus; Jane M Lane of Brutus; Catherine Lane of Brutus; the last three under the age of 21, also Calvin Lane of Pennsylvania, who is the son of Elijah Lane a son deceased.
